The date for submitting your entries is August 5, 2018. You will then be notified of his selections by August 10, 2018. Delivery of the selected photographs, to the Art Center, will be during the week of August 27, 2018.

Framing requirements are the same as in the past, black metal frame, with white matt and glass. The wire hanger needs to be two inches from the top of the frame. Your name, address and title need to be on the back as well as the price if you wish to sell it. There are no size requirements this year.

Wildlife Photo Workshop, Aug. 19

Wildlife Photo Workshop - Bring Your Camera Gear

Conservation photographer and environmental educator Alex Wiles will lead a two-hour interactive workshop "Floodplain Photography: How to Document an Ecosystem" from 2-4 p.m. Sunday, August 19, at the Betty Strong Encounter Center in the Lewis And Clark Interpretive Center, down by the river. Admission is free.

He will discuss in detail how to capture detailed images of wildlife on a white background using a variety of lighting techniques and photography equipment.

His creative images with high-key lighting of exotic fish and turtles in aquariums, titled "Missouri River Floodplain," are currently on display in the Interpretive Center Gallery. He encourages photographers to bring their camera and snap some photos of the displays.
